

WALL MOUNT DRAIN TRAP

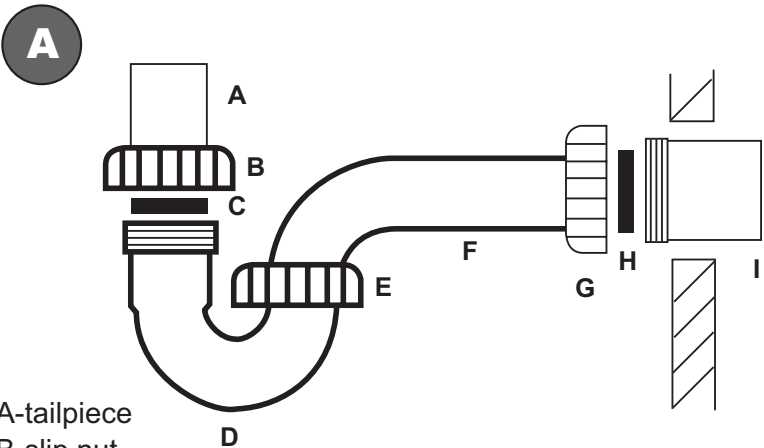
Used in combination with metal or plastic drain systems.
Won't deteriorate and is unaffected by strong drain cleaning chemicals.

Tools are not required to install this product. A pipe wrench may be needed to remove old drain parts.

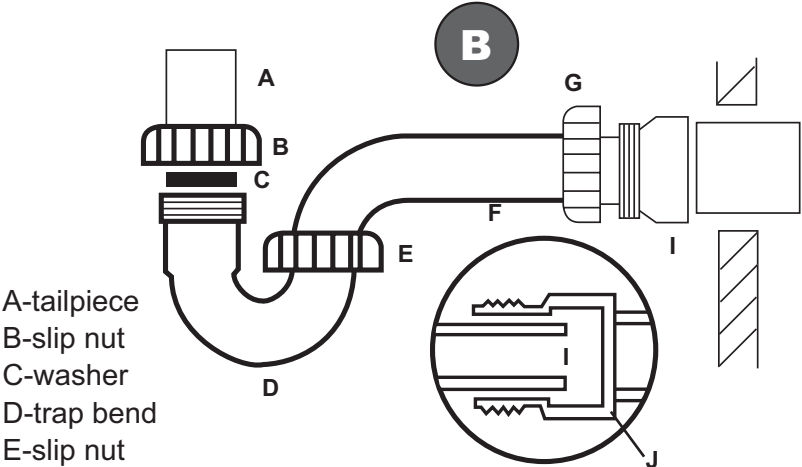
- To remove old drain trap:
1. Loosen upper and lower nuts on trap bend.
 2. Remove old trap bend being careful not to spill waste.
 3. Loosen wall nut and remove wall bend.

- To install new plastic trap:
1. For bathroom installation, slip upper nuts (threads down) and slip 1 1/2" x 1 1/4" reducing poly washer over tailpiece.
 2. For kitchen sink installation, slip upper nut (threads down) and 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" poly washer over tailpiece.
 3. Proceed with installation by attaching longer portion of trap bend to tailpiece.

4. If wall connection is standard 1 1/2" threaded pipe, install wall tube by using nut and washer from present wall tube and install directly into pipe as in illus. A.
 5. If wall connection is to 1 1/2" plastic pipe, a conversion adapter (purchased separately) will be required to enable proper installation as in illus. B.
- Avoid overtightening. Hand tighten all connections. Turn on water and check for leaks. If leak occurs, tighten nuts slightly.
