

As of July of 2011 California passed a law requiring carbon monoxide (CO) alarms in most residences. Many of the units installed at that time have already or will soon reach the end of their 7-year useful life, and will begin beeping every 30 seconds.

NOTE: Once an alarm sounds its 7-year end-of-life warning, it will not detect CO – leaving families unprotected.

## IT'S THE LAW IN CALIFORNIA:

Effective JULY 1, 2011 Single Family Homes Effective JAN 1, 2013 Multi-Family Homes Most single and multifamily homes are required to install CO alarms outside of each separate sleeping area in the immediate vicinity, and on every level of the dwelling (including basements).
