


ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS (CONTINUED)

3 Mount the rotary pump (2) assembly on to the base plate (5) using 4mm allen key.

> "Please note that pump must be positioned in the same way as shown in the picture."

Push the Base plate (5) back and reassemble the castor (7) onto the drain tank.





Assemble the Handle (4) with the base plate (5) with the help of two 13mm bolts (included in the pack).

Take the feeder hose (9) and connect one end with the tank outlet (8) and the other end with the rotary pump (2) inlet using clamps.


Take the discharge hose (1) and connect one end with the pump outlet using clamp.


