Functional and Economical

Our wire dispensers are made of heavy gauge wire to retain their shape and withstand normal use.

The clean, bright appearance of powder-coated wire looks attractive and provides a professional image.

For best results, clean by washing the surface with a diluted solution of a mild, non-abrasive detergent in cold or warm water and a nonabrasive cloth. Standard hospital cleaning supplies can be used.

Dry with a soft cloth. Do not use any solvent-based materials, abrasives (e.g. Scotch-brite, steel wool), or apply excessive force during cleaning.
