Assembly

1. Remove one wheel from the axle. Remove cotter pin and washers.



2. Remove roll pins from both sides of the axle support bracket.



3. Slide the axle out of the axle support bracket partially, and install the stair climbers on the axle.


Note: The lower holes on the stair climbers are for 10" pneumatic wheels, and upper holes are for 8" solid wheels.

- 4. Re-insert the axle back into the axle support bracket, and re-install the wheel, using the washers and cotter pins. (Replace cotter pin if it is damaged or broken.)
- 5. Replace the roll pins originally removed from behind the axle support brackets into the holes behind the stair climbers.
- 6. Pierce red plastic inserts on the frame thru the screw holes pre-drilled on the frame. Install stair climber top pivot, using screw and lock nut provided in the kit.
